In term of cost firearm related injuries rank fifth globally in patient admissions



90 % of killed and injured victims by explosive weapons are civilians.



Average of worldwide hospitalized firearm related patients cost per year \$183 million



2013-2018 deaths and injured victims by unreflective weapons in Lebanon are 147
